## SPA to hold public session on terminal

Tuesday, October 27, 2009

As part of its planning process for the makeover of Union Pier cruise terminal and the surrounding property, the State Ports Authority will host a public listening session at 7 p.m. Wednesday at the passenger terminal at 196 Concord St.

Planners from Cooper Robertson will lead the meeting, which will include a series of breakout sessions encouraging broad-based participation.

Parking in port lots will be available for free for those attending the session. Additional parking is available in the Cumberland Street parking garage or on Concord Street.

The public also will be invited to have input on the preliminary plan when it is presented in a mid-December public meeting.
