Clients and vendors operating at the Port of Charleston, please note that the SCSPA is making a tariff change regarding the 2009 Thanksgiving Holiday period.

Friday, November 27, 2009 will be a regular work day for SCSPA terminal operations employees. Holiday pay will not be required.

This does not necessarily mean that ocean carriers will choose to operate on that day, only that if they do, regular SCSPA rates will apply and not holiday rates.

We have not yet received each ocean carrier's gate operation plans. Thanksgiving Thursday is an ILA no-work day. We will issue a separate Client Advisory regarding anticipated ocean carrier gate hours and days of operation.
