Gangway:	Gangway in place. Dock level or balcony level embark/debark.

Vehicle Storage:	Vehicle storage is located at the Port. It is a controlled access area available only to cruise passengers. Storage fees are payable at entry.
Transition:	Complimentary shuttle service is provided between the terminal and vehicle storage on both departure and return days. Luggage services are provided in a dedicated area between vehicles and the terminal.
