



Debarment from Procurement Process.

A. Publication of list of persons or entities debarred.

The Director of Procurement will cause a list of persons or entities debarred from selection as contractors or vendors to be published on the Procurement Section of the Authority's website and in such other locations as deemed appropriate. Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, the failure to include a person or entity in the published list does not preclude application of this policy to debar that person or entity from selection as a contractor or vendor.

B. False and misleading information.

Any person or entity that provides false or misleading information to the Authority with regard to bids; contracts; purchase orders; opportunities to quote, bid, or submit proposals; solicitations; and any other arrangements for providing materials and services to the Authority will be permanently debarred from selection as a contractor or vendor and from providing materials or services to the Authority. Debarment under this provision applies regardless of when the false or misleading information is discovered and will be enforced immediately if the person or entity is a contractor or vendor or is providing materials and services to the Authority when the false or misleading information is discovered.

C. Involvement in litigation with the Authority.

Any contractor or vendor who is an adverse party to any litigation involving the Authority is debarred from selection as a contractor or vendor, directly or indirectly (e.g., subcontractor), and from providing materials or services to the Authority. This debarment applies from the date the litigation is filed until it is concluded through a final judgment issued by a court of competent jurisdiction. This provision applies if the contractor or vendor is an adverse party to the litigation in any manner whatsoever, including as a plaintiff, defendant, third-party plaintiff, or third-party defendant. This provision applies to all contracts; purchase orders; opportunities to quote, bid, or submit proposals; solicitations; and any other arrangements for providing materials or services to the Authority issued or becoming effective after the date this policy is adopted as part of the Authority's Procurement Policies and Procedures.
